Your application of March 29, 1957 regarding the dual completion of the above well states that it is your intention to dually complete this well in the Greenhorn and Graneros-Dakota formations as a gas-gas dual completion. Memo #18-56 which was distributed to the operators June 18, 1956 does not include the Greenhorn formation as one which may be approved for dual completion by this office.

However, as the well is a gas-gas dual and the Greenhorn is merely another gas-producing horizon in the Upper Cretaceous formation I am recommending to Mr. Porter that your dual completion be approved as submitted.

It is understood that the well will be equipped as set out in your application. Upon final completion request for administrative approval should be made to Mr. A. L. Porter as set out in Rule 112.
