The following surface restoration work needs to be performed on location before final abandonment can be approved.

1. Well should be plugged and a regulation marker (with well name and and legal location inscribed) cemented in the well bore. *OK*
- ✓ 2. All fenced pits must be filled in and the fences removed.
3. Oil stained soil must be cleaned up and buried or removed to an appropriate landfill.
4. Remove all production equipment.
- ✓ 5. Remove all purchaser's equipment (*meters + man*)
6. Remove concrete slab from the location.
- ✓ 7. Remove all deadmen (anchors) from the location.
- ✓ 8. Remove all abandoned flowlines and or risers from the location.
- ✓ 9. Remove all debris from the location.
10. The access road needs to be blocked with an earthen berm at the point it joins the main road.
11. The access road needs to be waterbarred to divert water to the sides of the road.
- ✓ 12. Pad and or access road must be leveled, disced and prepared for seeding.
- ✓ 13. All disturbed areas will be reseeded during July 1 and Sept. 15th with BLM revised Seed Mix No. I.
