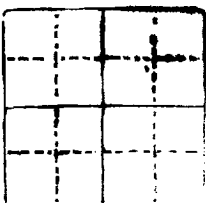
1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to the attached sheet for general conditions of approval.

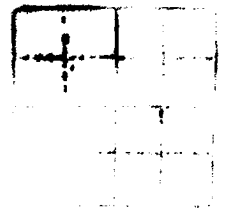

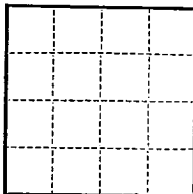

DETAILS OF WORK

1. A string of 6 5/8" surface casing will be set at 400' and cemented from shoe to surface of ground.
2. The objective sand will be the Pictured Cliff to be encountered at an approximate depth of 3650'.
3. The producing string of casing will be 5 1/2" casing to be set in top of the Pictured Cliff sand and cemented with 250 sac cement.
4. The Pictured Cliff sand will be drilled with rotary tools, using gas to circulate.
5. Total depth of the well will be approximately 3700'.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

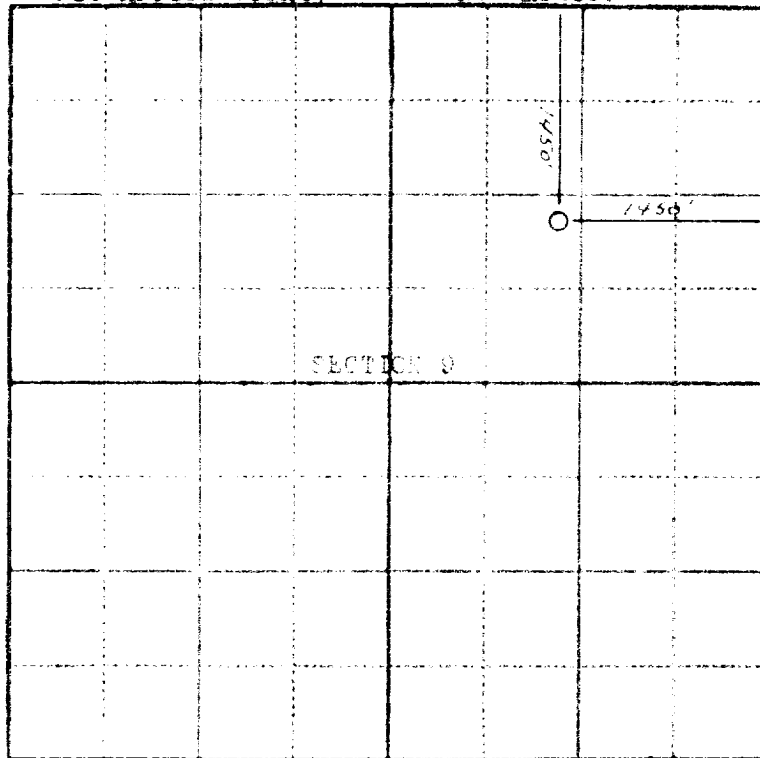
