

THE APPLICATION OF CONSOLIDATED OIL 4 GAS. INC. FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1222

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on July 11, 1962, for permission to complete its Tribal "C" Well No. 12-8 located in Unit E of Section 8, Township 26 North, Range 3 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs and Basin-Dakota Pools.

How, on this 23rd day of July, 1962, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That waivers of objection have been received from the offset operator and the waiting period as prescribed by said rule, may be dispensed with at this time.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and commonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc. be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Tribal "C" Well No. 12-8 located in Unit E of Section 8, Township 26 North, Range 3 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Tapacito-Pistured Cliffs and Basin-Dakota Poels through parallel strings of tubing.

provided nowever. That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER. That applicant shall take packerleakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
