DETAILS OF WORK

Moved in cable tools, pulled tubing, cleaned well out to bottom. Gave sand-oil treatment using 7,700 gallons diesel oil and 11,500\* sand, flushed with 2,300 gallons diesel oil. Interval treated 2132' to 2226'. Breakdown pressure 1100\*, maximum treating pressure 1100\*, minimum 1100\*. Final pressure zero. Injection rate 35.7 barrels per minute. Cleaned out after treatment and re-ran tubing.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
