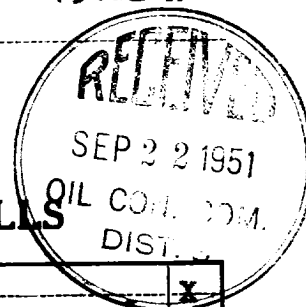

Nipped up to 10 3/4" casing, tested BOP and casing with 1,250 lbs. pressure and held for 30 minutes at 5:00 P.M., September 20, 1951.
