Standard Gas Production Unit
for "W" Well 9-6**

Gentlemen:

In accordance with Order No. 2-1193, Rule 2 (B), request is made for administrative approval of a non-standard gas production unit for Northwest Production Corporation "W" Well 9-6, which is located in the NW/4 of the NE/4 of Section 6, Township 26 North, Range 4 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The proposed non-standard unit for "W" Well 9-6 consists of 80 acres plus Lot 1 of 41.99 acres plus Lot 2 of 41.13 acres making a total of 162.72 acres. The unorthodox size of the proposed unit is caused by a variation in the legal subdivision of the United States Public Land Survey, and it lies within a single governmental section, all of which is subject to an oil and gas lease in favor of Northwest Production Corporation. It is reasonable to presume that all of the non-standard unit is productive of gas.

According to our records, and as indicated on the attached plat, El Paso Natural Gas Company, P. O. Box 1492, El Paso, Texas, owns the oil and gas lease for Sections 31 and 32, Township 27 North, Range 4 West, which offsets our Well "W" 9-6. Copy of this request for approval of a non-standard gas production unit is being sent to El Paso Natural Gas Company by registered mail.
