Dear Sir:

The allowable for your Alto USL #1 well in the Puerto-Chiquito Gallup Pool was reduced from 70 barrels to 65 barrels effective November 1, 1960 based on Gas-Oil Ratio test submitted on Form C-116 by Mr. H.D. Miller.

Rule 301 (D) of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rules and Regulations says in part "No well shall be assigned an allowable greater than the amount of oil produced on official test during a 24-hour period". Therefore we cannot assign allowables in excess of 65 barrels per day.
