Dear Mr. Schwenn:

We received Forms C-104 for both the Basin Dakota and South Blanco Tocito zones of the above well.

As you know, this well was a non-standard location in the Basin Dakota Pool and the non-standard location was approved by an administrative order issued by our Santa Fe Office in November, 1964. At the time the original application was made it evidently was not your intention to also complete the well in the Tocito zone. The well is located within one mile of the boundary of the Largo-Gallup Pool; therefore the well location would also be non-standard for the Gallup zone. It will therefore be necessary that you make similar application for approval of the non-standard location in the Gallup zone.

We are also enclosing a supply of Form C-107, Application for Multiple Completion. This application should be submitted with the information as indicated on the form in order that administrative order can be written approving the dual completion. Send two copies of Form C-107 to this office with one set of exhibits as indicated and send two copies of Form C-107 with exhibits to our Santa Fe Office, Box 2088, Santa Fe.

As your location has been approved for the Dakota portion of this dual we will approve Form C-104 as it pertains to the Dakota Formation as soon as we have received a packer leakage test indicating separation of the zones, and if the well is ready to be produced the Dakota may be produced prior to approval of the multiple completion and of the non-standard location for the Gallup zone. However the Gallup zone should not be produced until the above matters have been taken care of.

It will therefore be necessary that you submit an application for approval of the non-standard location in the Basin Dakota pool.

We are also enclosing a copy of Form C-107, Application for Multiple Completion. This application should be submitted with the information as indicated on the form in order that administrative order can be written approving the dual completion. Send two copies of Form C-107 to this office with one set of exhibits as indicated and send two copies of Form C-107 with exhibits to our Basin Office, Box 2085, Santa Fe.

As your location has been approved for the Basin Dakota pool of this dual well we will approve Form C-107 as it pertains to the Basin Dakota pool as soon as we have received a packer leakage test indicating separation of the zones, and if the well is ready to be produced the Basin Dakota pool should be produced prior to approval of the multiple completion and of the non-standard location for the Basin Dakota pool. However, the Basin Dakota pool should not be produced until the above matters have been taken care of.
