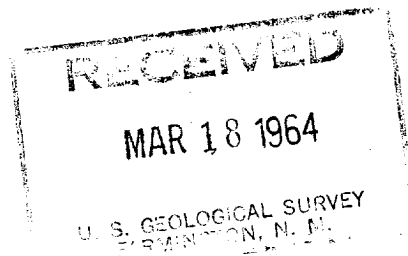

This well will be located 1850' from the North line and 1850' from the East line at an elevation of 6804.6 ground level. A 17" hole will be drilled, 12 3/4", 45# casing will be set at 300' and cemented with 295 cubic feet of cement. Drill 10 5/8" hole and set 7 5/8" 26.40# casing at 3760 cemented with 215 cubic feet of cement. The dedicated acreage will remain the same.
