Please find attached a plat on location of subject well located 790' F/NL and 1850' F/EL, Sec. 18, T-26, R-5, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico

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The original application to drill dated October 20, 1964, was for a single zone Dakota Formation completion only. Examination of the logs after reaching Total Depth indicated presence of possible Blanco Tocito Gallup oil production. This zone was perforated and fractured and is currently producing approximately 70 barrels of oil per day. The testing of this zone is still in progress. We propose to complete the Dakota zone in approximately sixty days from date. We request approval of this location as an unorthodox location in the Blanco Tocito Gallup pool.

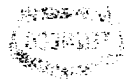

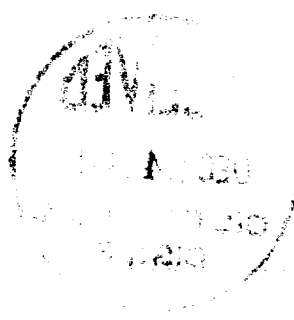
