We have your application requesting administrative approval of a non-standard location in the South Blanco-Tocito Oil Pool for the above well which is located 790 feet from the North line and 1850 feet from the East line of Section 18.

As the well complies with the well location requirements of Rule 104 and is not within the horizontal limits of the South Blanco-Tocito Oil Pool or within one mile thereof, it will not be necessary to obtain an exception to the rules and regulations governing the pool.

If the horizontal limits of the South Blanco-Tocito Oil Pool are extended to include this acreage, the well will automatically be excepted from the well location requirements of the special pool rules as it was completed in compliance with the rules governing the location at the time of the completion.
