

THE APPLICATION OF CAULKINS OIL  
COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1691

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Caulkins Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 23, 1965, for permission to dually complete its Breech Well No. 307 located in Unit M of Section 13, Township 26 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 13th day of December, 1965, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Caulkins Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Breech Well No. 307 located in Unit M of Section 13, Township 26 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

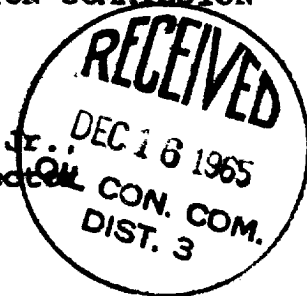
PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

OF THE OIL AND GAS COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, the Commission has made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 23, 1967, for permission to drill complete the Basin-Isleta Well No. 107 located in Unit M of Section 13, Township 36 North, Range 7 West, 10 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Basin-Mesa Verde Pool and the Basin-Isleta Pool.

Now, on this 11th day of December, 1967, the Commission Director finds:

- (1) That application was duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of oil and gas wells have been duly notified and that all operations have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
- (3) That the proposed dual completion will not cause undue impairment of correlative rights;
- (4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and conform with sound engineering practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Basin Oil Company, Inc., the same is hereby authorized to drill complete the Basin-Isleta Well No. 107 located in Unit M of Section 13, Township 36 North, Range 7 West, 10 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Basin-Mesa Verde Pool and the Basin-Isleta Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take proper lease fees upon completion and annually thereafter during the annual deliverability test period for the Basin-Isleta Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That production of this well is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
