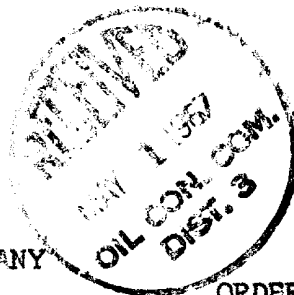


THE APPLICATION OF MARATHON OIL COMPANY
FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.



ORDER NO. MC-1766

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Marathon Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on April 19, 1967, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla Apache Well No. 13 located in Unit M of Section 33, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

NOW, on this 24th day of April, 1967, The Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That waivers of objection have been received from offset operators and the waiting period as prescribed by said rule may be dispensed with at this time.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Marathon Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla Apache Well No. 13 located in Unit M of Section 33, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

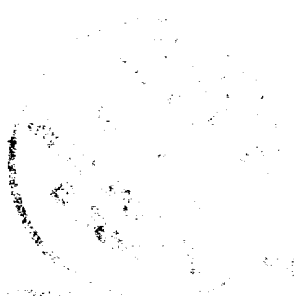
That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
