ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 1, 1973, for permission to dually complete its Klein Well No. 21 located in Unit F of Section 34, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Chacra Formation.

Now, on this 8th day of June, 1973, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(3) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Klein Well No. 21 located in Unit F of Section 34, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Chacra formation through parallel strings of 2-7/8 inch casing cemented in a common well bore.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
ON THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 113-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 1, 1973, for permission to drill a well in the El Paso 2 well located in Unit 2 of Section 17, Township 16 North, Range 3 West, N40W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Richard Cliffs Pool and the Chaco Formation.

Now, on this 8th day of June, 1973, the Secretary-Commissioner finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 113-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rules;
- (3) That the proposed well completion will not cause water non-impair correlative risks;
- (4) That the mechanics of the proposed well completion are feasible and consistent with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to drill complete the well No. 10-10-1 located in Unit 2 of Section 17, Township 16 North, Range 3 West, N40W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Richard Cliffs Pool and the Chaco Formation through parallel strings of 2-7/8 inch casing cemented in a common well bore.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 113-A.

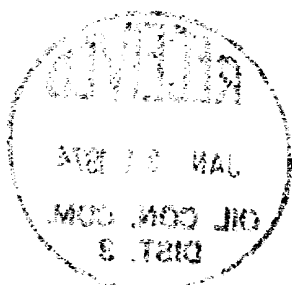
PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take proper-leak tests upon completion and annually thereafter.
