1. Spudded 12-1/4" surface hole at 5:00 P.M., 8-9-74. Drilled to T.D. of 390 ft. R.K.B..
2. Ran 8 jts. of 8-5/8", 24.0#, E-55 surface casing. Landed at 345 ft. R.K.B. Cemented with 225 sacks of class "A" cement. Plug down at 3:15 A.M., 8-10-74. Cement circulated to surface.
3. Nipped up and pressure tested surface casing and B.O.P. to 1000 psi for 10 minutes. Test OK.
4. Drilled out from under surface casing with 7-7/8" hole, with mud on 8-10-74.

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Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
