

MARATHON OIL COMPANY  
DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR SURFACE USE

JICARILLA APACHE NO. 17  
1850' FSL, 790' FEL, SECTION 34, T.26N., R.5W.,  
RIO ARriba COUNTY, NEW MEXICO  
GROUND ELEVATION: 6614'

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1. The attached map depicts the location of existing main roads and access roads in the vicinity of the location of Jicarilla Apache Well No. 17, a Pictured Cliffs gas development well Marathon Oil Company proposes to drill during August, 1974.
2. Approximately 1600 feet of access road will be constructed east from the Jicarilla Apache No. 17 site to an existing road.
3. Six gas wells are located within one-half mile of the proposed drill site.
4. Lateral roads to wells within a half-mile radius of the proposed location are shown on the attached map.
5. Only gas production is anticipated, so there will be no tank batteries or liquid hydrocarbon treating facilities. A gas flow line will be installed to the nearest existing line.
6. Water for drilling will be obtained from Tapacito Wash or one of its tributaries within three miles of the drill site. Water will be hauled by truck to the drilling site.
7. All garbage and trash will be dumped in a trash pit and buried to a depth of five feet after completion of the well. Drill cuttings will be buried in the reserve pit after the well is completed.
8. There will be no camp or permanent type structure.
9. There will be no airstrip.
10. The drilling rig will sit on a 250' x 250' level location with the mud tanks and reserve pit on the west, fill side of the location.
11. Pits will be covered and restored to as near natural condition as possible after a dry-out period. The level location and road will be utilized for operation and maintenance of the well.
12. A cut of approximately six feet will be required on the southeast side of the location with the earth removed used as fill on the northwest side.
