Approval is requested to conduct annual packer leakage tests on this well to assure that there is no communications between South Blanco Pictured Cliff and Fruitland Coal.

This well is presently being produced as a single Pictured Cliff with 1 1/4" tubing run to 3164' with a seal assembly set in a Baker Model "D" packer at 3088', separating Pictured Cliff and Fruitland formations.

Pictured Cliff perforations: 3116' to 3178'.

Fruitland Coal perforations: 2950' to 3034'.

See attached diagram.

Approval is also requested to continue flowing well as it is presently completed until well condition requires workover or plug and abandon.

If any remedial work is performed on this well, Fruitland Coal zone will be plugged and abandoned at that time.

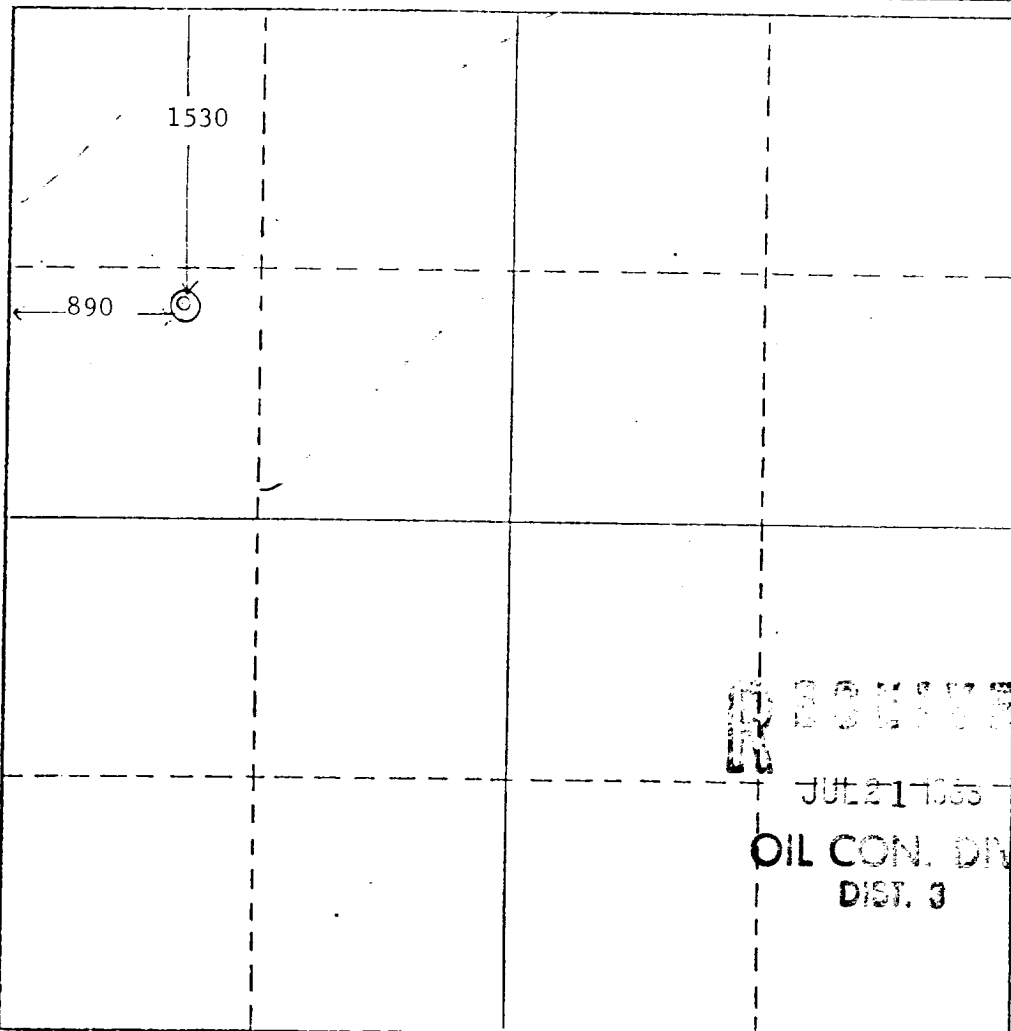
