

Reference is made to the following wells located in T. 26 N., R. 7 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, lease No. SF-079161:

Also referenced is your letter dated July 1, 1991, which stated the wells have not been commingled and you are presently evaluating the performance of the other commingled wells on the lease to see if commingling should be performed.
