

- (16) Reserve pit will be covered and cleaned up then reseeded with BLM recommended seeding program with 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Crested Wheatgrass, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Smooth Brome, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fourwing Saltbrush (dewinged) and 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Nomad Alfalfa per acre. Reseeded area will include all location and reserve pit area to within 5' of all facilities. Seeding shall be done between July 15 and Oct. 15. All facilities maintained by Caulkins Oil Company shall be painted grey, number 56357.
- (17) New location will be 300' off existing road. Area to be disturbed has medium coverage of Blue Grama and Sage Brush. Soil is sandy clay loam.
