1. Prep to plug and abandon the Jicarilla #5 on 6-6-78. *
2. Ran 4½" cement retainer on 2-3/8" tubing. Set retainer at 5500'. Squeezed Mesaverde perforations from 5630'-6202' w/150 sx cement. Spotted 50 sx plug across Pictured Cliffs perforations; 3970'-3990'.
3. Shot off 7" casing at 1370'. Perforated at 3750' w/4 holes at the base of Ojo Alamo. Spotted 75 sx neat cement at 3600' and squeezed 36 sx into formation.
4. Pulled and laid down 37 jts 7" 23# K-55 casing. Rigged down jacks. Rigged up to run 2-3/8" tubing.
5. Spotted 50 sx plug at base of surface casing 380'-280'. Pulled tubing to 120'. Spotted 50 sx plug from 126'-20' (surface casing), laid down tubing.
6. Installed dry hole marker w/10 sx plug 20' to surface on 6-16-78. Well plugged and abandoned as a dry hole on 6-15-78.

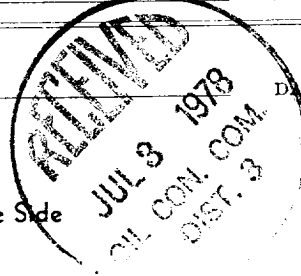

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
