

INSTRUCTIONS

General: This form is designed for submitting a complete and correct well completion report and log on all types of lands and leases to either a Federal agency or a State agency, or both, pursuant to applicable Federal and/or State laws and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State agency. See instructions on items 22 and 24, and 23, below regarding separate reports for separate completions, and the number of copies to be submitted. If not filed prior to the time this summary report is submitted, copies of all currently available logs (lithology, geologists, sample and core analysis, all types electric, etc.), formation and pressure tests, and directional surveys, should be attached hereto, to the extent required by applicable Federal and/or State laws and regulations. All attachments should be listed on this form, see item 32.

Item 1: If there are no applicable State requirements, headings of Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 13: Lithology which elevation is used as reference surface for depth measurements given in other sections on this form, and in any attachments.

Item 22 and 24: If there are no applicable State requirements, use the following for separate reports for separate completions, so state in item 22 and 24 show the provisions for each additional interval to be separately produced, showing the additional data pertinent to such interval. Submit a separate report (page) on this form, adequately identified, item 29: separate report for each additional supplemental records for this well should show the details of any multiple stage reworking and the location of the cementing tool.

Item 33: Submit a separate completed report on this form for each interval to be separately produced. (See instruction for items 22 and 24 of 1963).
