

9. Wellsite Layout

The drillsite location will be graded and will be approximately 250' by 250' with natural drainage to the north. Care will be taken while grading to control erosion.

10. Plans for Restoration of Surface

- A. Following drilling and completion operations all equipment and material not needed for operations will be removed. Pits containing fluid will be fenced until they dry out and will then be filled and the location cleaned of all trash and junk.
- B. After abandonment, any special rehabilitation and/or revegetation requirements (specified by regulatory agency) will be complied with and accomplished as expeditiously as possible.

11. Other information

If, during operations, any historic or prehistoric ruin, monument or site, or any object of antiquity is discovered, work will be suspended and the discovery will be reported to the appropriate regulatory agency.

The area covered by the location and proposed access road is approximately 2 acres.
