THE APPLICATION OF SUPRON ENERGY CORPORATION FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2437

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Supron Energy
Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation
Division on May 5, 1978, for permission to dually complete its
Jicarilla H Well No. 9 located in Unit A of Section 17, Township
26 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico,
in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Tapacito
Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 10th day of May, 1978, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That waivers of objection have been received from such offsetting operators.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Supron Energy Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla H Well No. 9 located in Unit A of Section 17, Township 26 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
