THE APPLICATION OF BOLIN OIL COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Bolin Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on February 12, 1979, for permission to dually complete its Candado Well No. 21 located in Unit B of Section 4, Township 26 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Chacra formation and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 13th day of February, 1979, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That waivers of objection have been received from such offsett ng operators.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Bolin Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Candado Well No. 21 located in Unit B of Section 4, Township 26 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Chacra formation and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

Hereby Tetained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
