Dear Mr. Verquer,


Reference is made to your recent request for administrative approval to exercise commingling authority granted by Division Order DHC-660, issued July 29, 1987.

In speaking with Frank Chavez, Aztec District Supervisor, he advised me that commingled be allowed only by producing through a tubing configuration detailed in the application which was approved by DHC-660. Specifically, this involved a single string of tubing, packer isolation between the 3 zones, with production through reverse-flow check valves.

If you would like to present your case before an examiner at public hearing, you may be granted the authority to produce the well in its present condition.
