Dear Frank:

We have reviewed the gas and oil production on our Jicarilla J #12E (M Section 35, T26N-R5W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico) which is a commingled Dakota/Gallup/Mesaverde well as per NMOCD Order #7507. Based on production figures from nearby Dakota, Gallup, and Mesaverde wells in the area and a production log run over the subject well's producing interval, we feel that the following production allocation on the subject well's commingled zones would be reasonably accurate:

	<u>Gas</u>	<u>Oil</u>
Dakota	80%	2%
Gallup	5%	96%
Mesaverde	15%	2%
