Commingling Allocation for Jicarilla Apache 102 Nos. 12E and (14E Rio Arriba County, New Mexico

On September 15, 1981, Amoco Production Company received approval to commingle production in Jicarilla Apache 102 Nos. 7E, 12E, and 14E (Administrative Order DHC-347).

Amoco comminded production from the Basin Dakota and B. S. Mesa Gallup pools in Jicarilla Anache 102 Nc. 12E and 14E on October 31, 1981. In accordance to Order R-4059 (Case No. 4443, November 10, 1970) the subject wells were flow tested before and after commingling to determine the allocation of production from each horizon. The results of these tests are recorded on the attached Form C-116's.

From these figures and the allocation formula in Order R-4059, a value for Gallup (f) was calculation for the oil and gas production from each well. These values, shown below, will be used for future allocation of production from the subject wells.

Jicarilla Apache 102 No. 14E	.127	.207

Jicarilla Apache 102 No. 7E is not yet commingled because of freezing of the production unit during testing.


It is anticipated that this problem will be solved and production commingled by December 31, 1981. When the well is commingled, the flow test results and allocation factors will be forwarded to your office.
