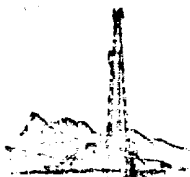

The attached copy of a U.S.G.S. topo map shows the general conditions that exist in the area of the proposed well.

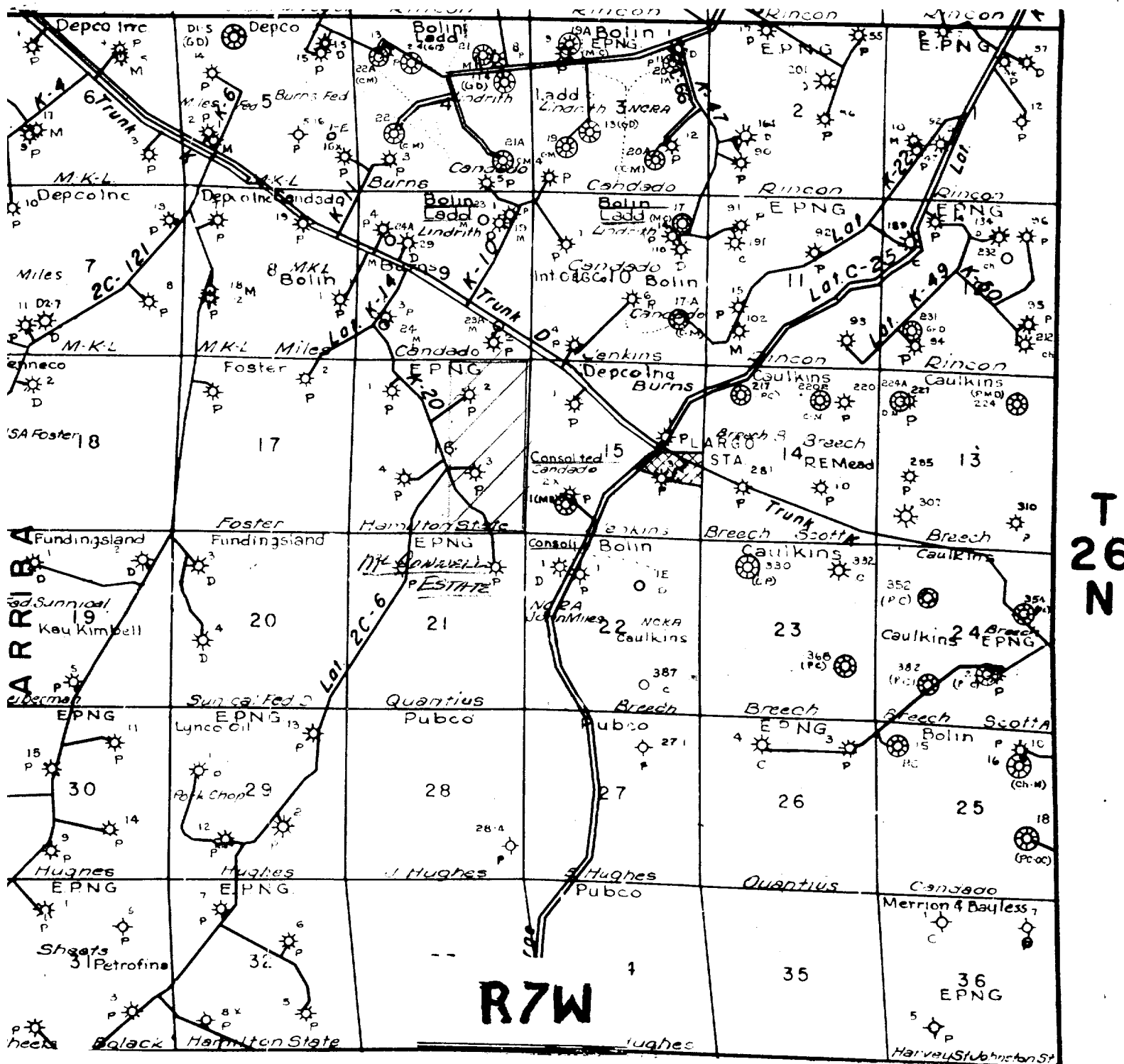

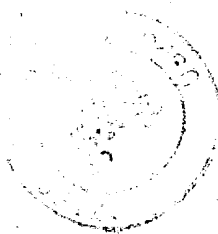
