ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Amoco Production Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on April 27, 1981, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla Apache A-118 Well No. 6 located in Unit N of Section 35, Township 26 North, Range 3 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 20th day of May, 1981, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations:
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified;
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Amoco Production Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla Apache A–118 Well No. 6 located in Unit N of Section 35, Township 26 North, Range 3 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.

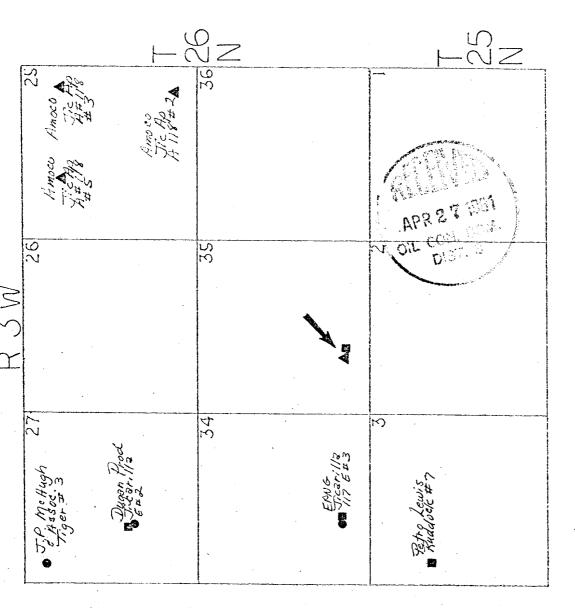
