

Packer Leak Jicarilla Contract 155 No. 27 Section 27, T26N, R5W Rio Arriba County, New Mexico Amoco Production Company

Amoco Production Company requests an extension in the time allotted to fix a known packer leak. The Jicarilla Contract 155 No. 27 has a packer leak as was evident in the January 31, 1986 packer leakage test. Amoco is currently attempting to measure the bottom hole pressures to determine if the well qualifies for commingling. Amoco will either file for commingling or initiate work to repair the packer leak when the pressures are obtained. Thus, we request the extension of time to fix the packer leak until the proper course of action can be determined.
