OF UNORTHODOX LOCATION:

CANADA OJITOS UNIT #23 (N-22) SE/4SW/4 SEC. 22, T-26N, R-1W

1302' FSL, 1413' FWL

Gentlemen:

Benson-Montin-Greer Drilling Corp., operator of the Canada Ojitos Unit, hereby requests under Rule 4 of the Pool Rules (Order R-6469-A) administrative approval of the captioned unorthodox location.

All offsetting sections are within the twelfth expanded participating area of the Canada Ojitos Unit and so there are no offset operators to notify.

The reason for the unorthodox location is topography. The problems can be seen from the enclosed topographic map (Llaves quadrangle), on which is sketched the basic "window" (formed by square with sides 1650 feet from section lines).

The only practical location is at the mouth of the canyon in the southwest part of the section, at the point shown, 1302 feet from the south line and 1413 feet from the west line of section 22.
