Re: Reporting problems

Dear Virgil:

We are having serious problems handling the reports for your recent well completions in the East Puerto Chiquito Mancos Unit.

#34 K-5-26N-1E

This well is Wildcat Greenhorn and requires a 40 acre dedication plat. If the Greenhorn formation does not participate in the unit, the name will have to be changed.

#37 C-8-26N-1E/

This well is illegally downhole commingled.

#40 E-19-27N-1E

This well is downhole commingled Greenhorn/Graneros without approval. Will require 40 acre plats.

#41 F-20-27N-1E

Your report shows the Greenhorn formation temporarily abandoned under a bridge plug and no report of fracture, acid, etc. This temporary abandonment can be approved for a short time only after request on a sundry notice. (See Rule 202)

Authorization to produce, form C-104, cannot be approved for these wells until all proper documents and other approvals are received.
