Reference is made to the following Applications for Permit to Drill (APDs):

1. No. 3-E Jicarilla "L", NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 3, T. 24 N., R. 5 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, Jicarilla Contract 10.
2. No. 8-E Jicarilla "G", NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 2, T. 26 N., R. 5 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, Jicarilla Contract 150.
3. No. 8 Jicarilla "F", NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 33, T. 26 N., R. 4 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, Jicarilla Contract 107.

As discussed with Bob LaFollette of your Company on December 21, 1983, the subject APDs are hereby rescinded and returned due to drilling operations not being commenced within a six month extension period following the original approval date.

You are required to request surface rehabilitation instructions from this Office if construction activities occurred on the referenced drill sites. If this Office does not receive comment within 15 days, it will presume that no construction occurred and proceed accordingly. Later discovery that construction activities have in fact occurred, will result in assessment of liquidated damages.
