We have reviewed the gas and oil production on our Jicarilla G #8E (J Section 2, T26N-R5W, Rio Arriba County, NM) which is a commingled Gallup-Dakota well as per NMOCD Order #R-7539. Based on production figures from nearby Dakota and Gallup wells, log analyses, and our tests from the individual intervals during completion operations, we feel that the following production allocation on the subject well's commingled zones would be reasonably accurate:
