It is intended to add pay to the Dakota formation of the subject well in the following manner:

Trip out of hole with tubing. Selectively reperforate the Dakota interval. Fracture stimulate the Dakota with sand and gelled water. Clean out to plug back total depth after fracture treatment. Rerun tubing. Return the well to production.

The following stipulations will apply to this well unless a particular Surface Managing Agency (SMA) or private surface owner has supplied to BLM and the operator a contradictory environmental stipulation. The failure of the operator to comply with these requirements may result in the assessments or penalties pursuant to 43 CFR 3163.1 or 3163.2. A copy of these conditions of approval shall be present on the location during construction, drilling and reclamation activity.

An agreement between operator and fee land owner will take precedence over BLM surface stipulations unless (In reference to 43 CFR Part 3160) 1) BLM determines that operator's actions will affect adjacent Federal or Indian surface, or 2) operator does not maintain well area and lease premises in a workmanlike manner with due regard for safety, conservation and appearance, or 3) no such agreement exists, or 4) in the event of well abandonment, minimum Federal restoration requirements will be required.

1. Pits will be fenced during workover operation.
2. All disturbances will be kept on existing pad.
3. Remove all hydrocarbons from temporary pit prior to closure.
4. Workover fluids will be contained in a lined pit or frac tank.
