
Merrion Oil & Gas Corporation objects to the referenced proposed unorthodox location and hereby serves notice of such objection.

Current well spacing requirements in this area would require Merrion to drill, essentially, a 40 acre offset to this well in order to protect our lease from drainage. Based on interference studies in the nearby Gavilan Mancos Pool, we believe such close well spacing is unnecessary to effectively drain the reservoir and may result in the drilling of unnecessary or uneconomic wells.
