Please be advised that Amoco has had some dirtwork construction done that we believe was not authorized or approved by the BLM on the subject well. The Amoco drilling foreman did not realize the BLM needed to be involved with alterations of location construction on private surface, and instructed the land owner Steve Stevenson (who also is the dirt contractor) to construct some flare pits adjacent to the original location. Mr. Stevenson exceeded the dimensions required but did not notify the BLM or Amoco as he considered doing dirtwork on his own property did not require approval from other concerns.
