Reference: NMNM 80064 3160(17). MW Petroleum received notice that the CA for the Bear Canyon Unit #4 had expired on June 30, 1994, if the well had not produced since then.

Reference was made that there may have been a reporting of production error. There was not, the well has been Shut-in due to economics since June, 1992.

Because of everyday technological advances made in regards to horizontal drilling, MWP has been evaluating those techniques to determine the feasibility of applying them to the Bear 4. This well has a 5" liner that makes a horizontal recompletion difficult and expensive with today's technology. The other Bear Canyon Unit wells all are under Lease #8910195970 and were developed as a unit. MW Petroleum is requesting that the Bear #4 be thought of as in this Unit, not terminate the CA, and allow MWP to retain the lease and wellbore for future development.
