

Dear Mr. Greer:

Reference is made to your application of June 15, 1989 for a non-standard oil well location for your Canada Ojitos Unit Well No. 43(H-8) located 1632 feet from the North line and 1139 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 8, Township 26 North, Range 1 West, NMPM, West Puerto Chiquito Mancos Oil Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. All of said Section 8 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 640-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the West Puerto Chiquito Mancos Oil Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-6469-B, as amended, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
