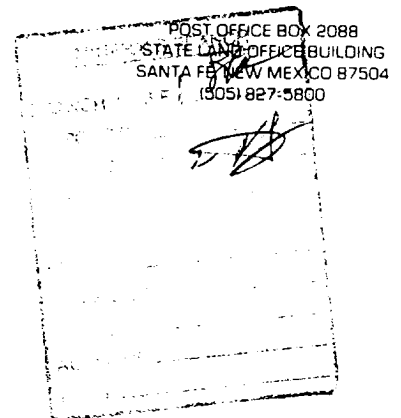



Dear Ms. Watson:

Reference is made to your application dated October 20, 1992 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your **MKL Well No. 14-8** to be located 390 feet from the South line and 735 feet from the West line (**Unit M**) of **Section 8, Township 26 North, Range 7 West**, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 8 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
