Reference is made to your application dated March 20, 1997 for an unorthodox "infill" gas well location for both the Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin-Dakota Pools for the proposed Reams Com Well No 2M to be drilled 1360 feet from the South line and 790 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 19, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Production from both pools in said well is to be included to the existing standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration units comprising the E/2 of said Section 19, which production is currently dedicated to Conoco's Reams Com Well No. 2 (API No. 30-039-23172), located at a standard gas well location 950 feet from the North line and 1765 feet from the East line (Unit B) of said Section 19.
