Dear Sirs:

We have received your Sundry Notice of December 12, 1998, for well Jicarilla 117E #7A, copy attached. Your approved Application for Permit to Drill required that the 1280 cubic feet of cement be used and circulated to the surface while placing the 7 inch casing. This was not done. The attached Sundry, reports that only 933 cubic feet of cement was used placing the top of cement in the 7 inch casing at 2890 feet. This does not provide adequate protection to the Nacimiento Formation or other shallow water sands (no cement present in well from 300 feet to 2890 feet).

The Condition of Approval for the attached Sundry is to reestablish circulation up the annulus of the 7 inch casing and to cement this casing to the surface as required in your approved Application for Permit to Drill.
