Dear Mr. Hayden:

Energen Resources recently finished completion operations on the subject well. In accordance to the approved C-103, the supervisor of the Aztec District Office of the NMOCD shall determine the proper production allocation.

The well was completed and cleaned out to total depth with both the Mesa Verde and Dakota perforations open. The Well was tested through a 1/4" choke for 4 hrs at a stabilized rate of 480 MCFD. The tubing was pulled and an RBP was set below the Mesa Verde perforations. The tubing was rerun and the Mesa Verde was tested through a 1/4" choke for 4 hrs at a stabilized rate of 410 MCFD. Both zones produced a trace of oil. It is recommended the following allocation:

<b>Mesa Verde</b>	<b>85%</b>	<b>50%</b>
<b>Dakota</b>	<b>15%</b>	<b>50%</b>
