Gentlemen:

I wish to call your attention to a memorandum issued from the cifice of the Cil Conservation Commission in Santa Fe, dated ostober 15, 1950, and addressed to all operators, which says:

"In accordance with our new rules and regulations, it has become customary for persons drilling a gas well to pool acreage to form a 160-acre drilling unit. In the future, therefore, it will be necessary for all C-101 forms for gas wells for all pools in the state to show what acreage is assigned to the proposed well. If the ownership is different or the type of land within the pooled unit is different - i.c., state, federal or fee - a plat must accompany the C-101 form showing the various ownerships and types of land.

It is also important to note that no gas well can expect a full allowable unless at least 158 acres are assigned to it, if said well has been drilled since January 1, 1950, or from that time on."
