



THE APPLICATION OF NORTHWEST PRODUCTION  
COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1617

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Northwest Production Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on March 18, 1965, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla Contract 152 Well No. "W" 2-7 located in Unit D of Section 7, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Tocito formation adjacent to the South Blanco-Tocito Oil Pool and gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 7th day of April, 1965, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

That the applicant herein, Northwest Production Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla Contract 152 Well No. "W" 2-7 located in Unit D of Section 7, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Tocito formation adjacent to the South Blanco-Tocito Oil Pool and gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

**PROVIDED HOWEVER,** That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

**PROVIDED FURTHER,** That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:** That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
