By copy of this letter to the effect operations listed in the application for lease operations, we ask that each of them be given a waiver concerning to the proposed drill completion and associated location.

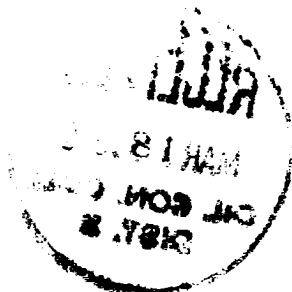

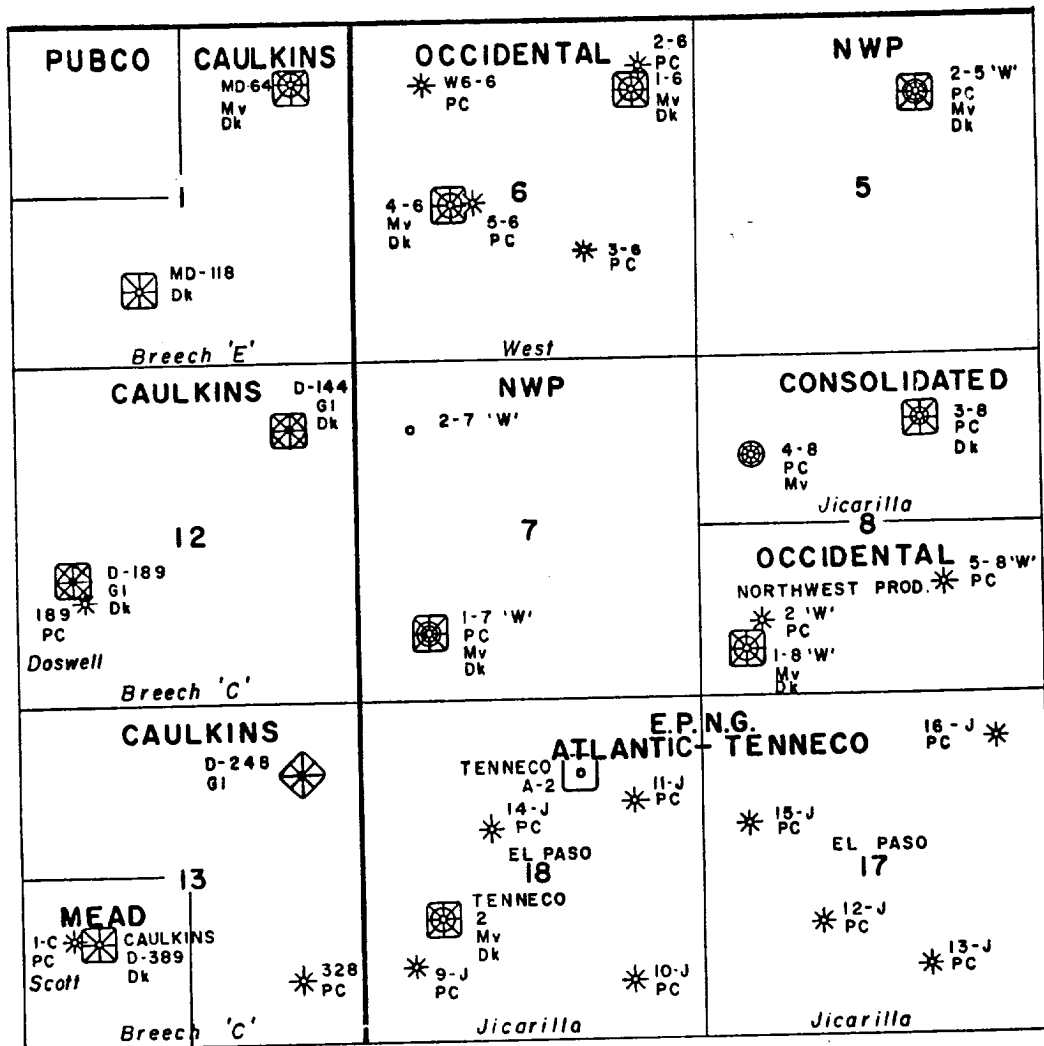

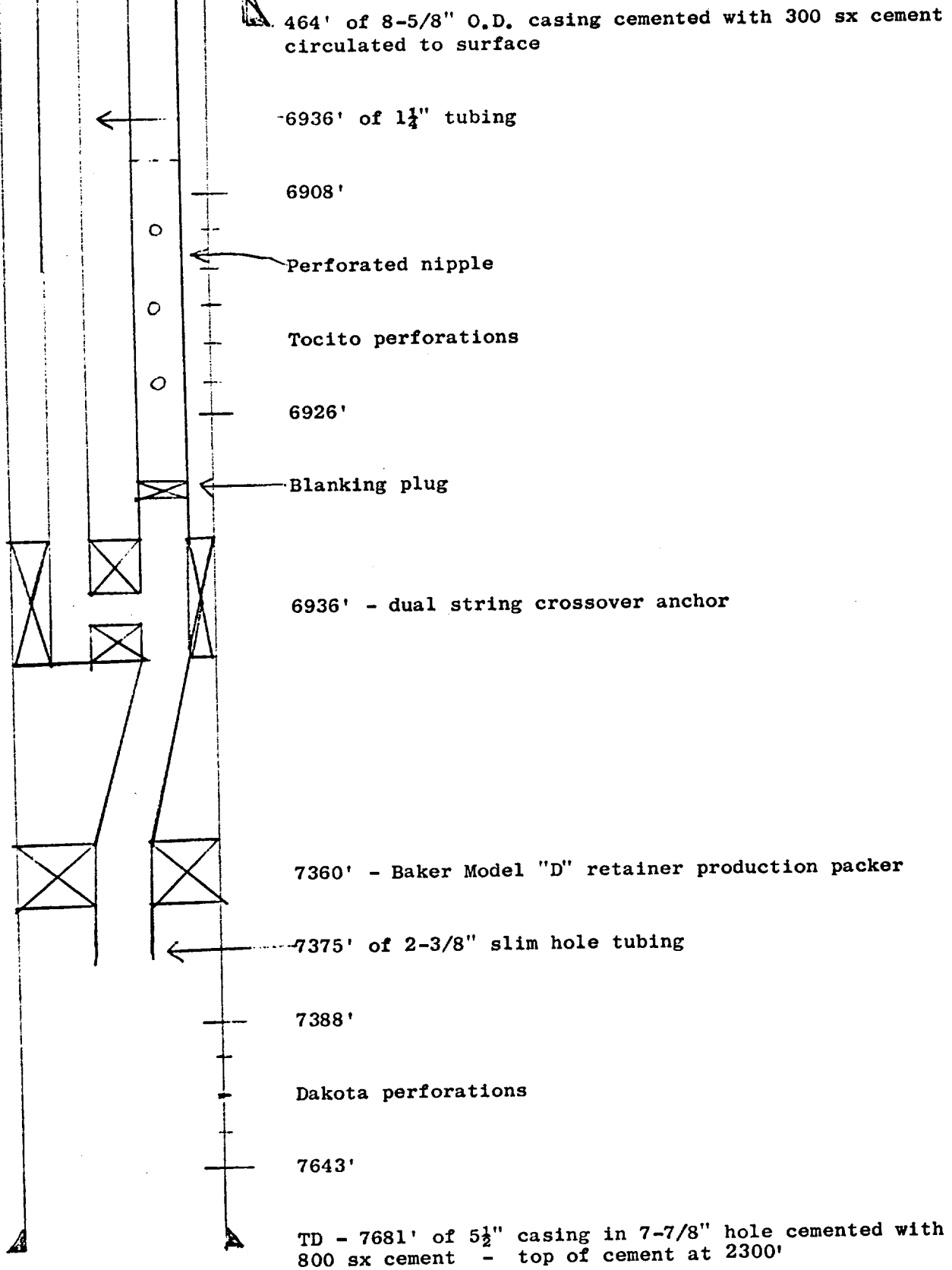
