That the applicant herein, Caulkins Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Breech "D" Well No. 341 located in Unit B of Section 21, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, EMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER. That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER CEDERAD: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
