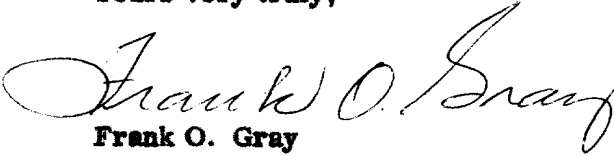
Gentlemen:

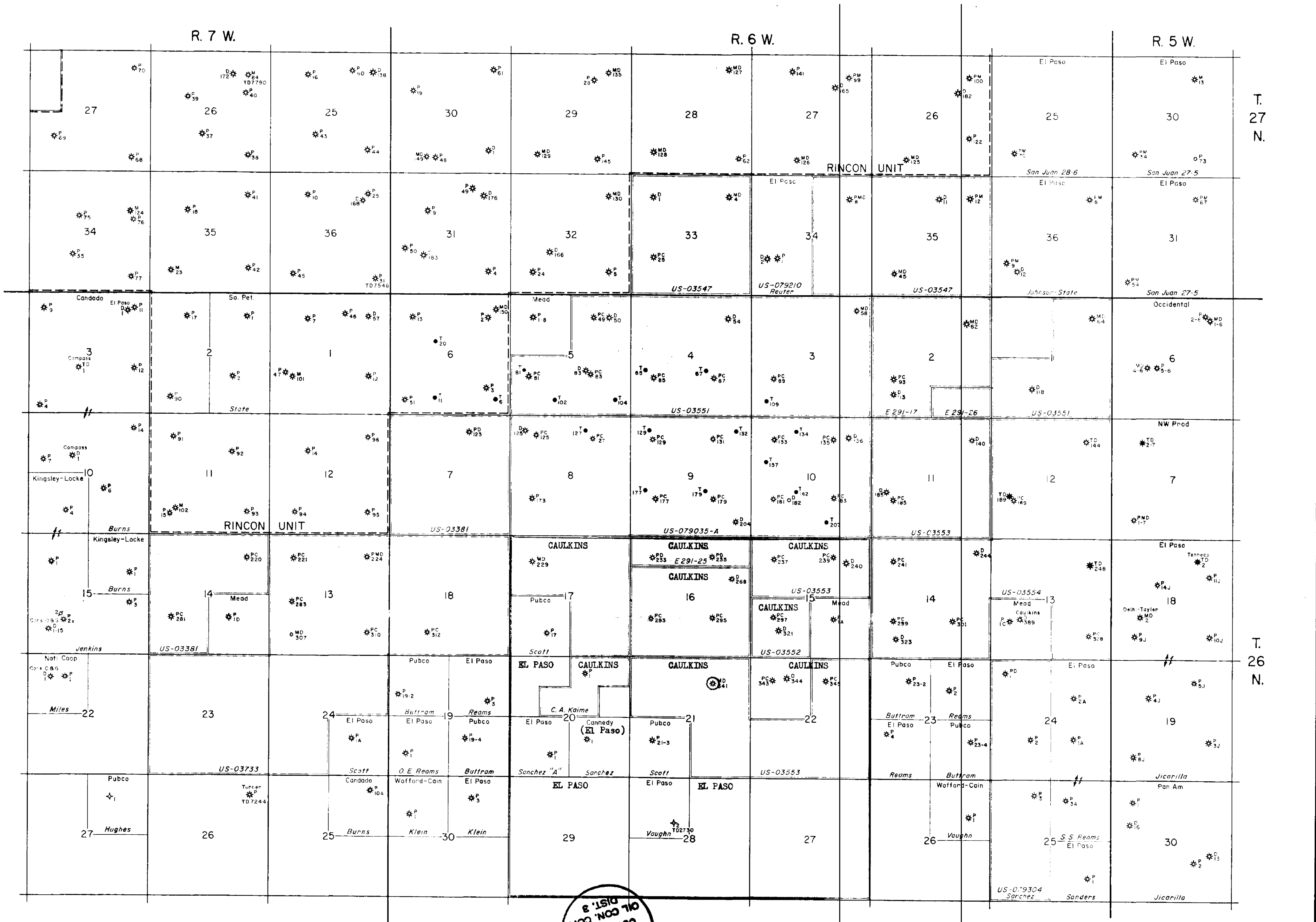
