Drilled out below 7-5/8" casing with air to TD 8185'. Run 4356' 5-1/2", 17 lb. and 15.5 lb. casing as liner. Liner set at 8191' KD. Hung at (top) 3836'. Cemented liner with 155 sx. 20% Diacel "D", 100 sx. 50/50 Pozmix with 4% gel. Plug down 8:15 A.M. 9/29/62. Drilled cement on top of liner. Pressured up on top of liner to 2800 psi. Liner leak indicated. Squeezed top of liner with 150 sx. regular cement with 2% calcium chloride. Drilled cement on top of liner. Pressure tested to 3000 psi. Pressure held OK.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
